Register to Vote

Check to see if you are registered at: www.Michigan.gov/vote. If so, it will give you all the information you need. If you are not registered, CALL YOUR CLERK.

Deadlines: Mail in October 19th Walk in (w/ proof of residency) October 20 – Nov 3rd

Request an Absentee Ballot

To request an Absentee Ballot, CALL YOUR CLERK now! 1st you'll receive an Application which you must fill out and return to the Clerk. Then you will receive the actual Ballot. Absentee Ballots will be sent out September 24th

3 Ways to Return Your Ballot

1. Hand deliver to Clerk
2. Drop in Ballot Box outside Clerk's office after Oct 1st
3. Place 2 stamps on & mail through US Postal Service.

MAIL YOUR BALLOT by OCTOBER 13th to make certain it is received on time.
